THE GLENFIDDICH STORY

The Glenfiddich 15 Year Old (previously called Solera Reserve) is based upon the traditional methods of sherry production first created in Jerez, Spain. William Grant & Sons has now introduced this methodology to the production of Glenfiddich, becoming the first distiller to use the Solera System in whisky maturation. At the heart of the Solera System is the impressive Solera vat, handmade with wood from the oak forests of Europe. To illustrate the process, as whisky is drawn from this vat, it is replenished with 15 year old Glenfiddich carefully selected by the Malt Master from American oak bourbon casks, Spanish oak sherry casks, and distinctively, rare new oak casks. This Glenfiddich is then married to a reservoir of extremely well matured whisky (the vat is never less than half full). Naturally, this sherry-like rite of passage imparts a special intensity to the Solera Reserve.
